- B. **Current negative Coggins Test** is required for all horses by the state of Michigan;
- C. **USEF Competing Membership Cards** for owner, trainer, rider, driver and handler. A copy of US Equestrian card must remain in the show office. Non-member fee will be charged if a current membership cards are not presented.
- D. **AHA Competition Level Membership** for owner, trainer, rider, driver, & handler;
- E. **USEF Amateur Certification** (if showing in any AT or AO classes);
- F. Proof of Ownership if newly purchased, leased or owner's name has changed;
- G. Check for total fees or Open signed check made out to "HAAM"

Classes with 3 or less entries may be combined or canceled.

OPEN CHECKS must be closed out prior to leaving show grounds. The show management will close out all remaining open checks one hour after the last class. Offering of an open check constitutes agreement with this policy.

CLASS SCRATCHES – Exhibitors may scratch a class any time prior to the beginning of the session in which the class is scheduled. Money from the scratched class may be applied towards other class fees. No cash refunds will be made for scratched classes.

CHECKS will be deposited on May 20, 2009. A \$35.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks. All funds must be in US currency.

PAVILION & SHOW INFORMATION

Paramedic: The Paramedic will be located at the show office or available by radio from the show office.

Farrier – will be in the auditorium located west of Pavilion Atrium.

Only the Veterinarian and Farrier contracted by the show will be allowed to provide vet and farrier services on the show grounds. The only exception will be if the customer/exhibitor has specifically requested another vet or farrier.

SHOW GROUNDS: The MSU Pavilion is located at the Michigan State University in East Lansing, MI. Admission to the show grounds will not be allowed before 8:00 AM on the morning of Thursday May 29, 2009. All parking will be in designated areas only. Unloading and loading is only permitted in designated areas. If loading or unloading inside the pavilion, the vehicle must be removed immediately upon completion. ALL DOGS ON THE GROUNDS MUST BE LEASHED. Smoking in the Pavilion and all barns is prohibited. The Pavilion competition arena is approximately 110' x 214' with a sand based composition. The warm up arenas have a sand footing.

CAMPING FEE at MSU is \$45.00 per unit during the show REGARDLESS of LENGTH of STAY. All camper units/tents that are occupied over night must display a valid permit that can be purchased at the show office. Permits must be visibly displayed. Running of generators after midnight is prohibited. Note, most camping spots do not have water availability.

Medical Waste: Sharps containers are available, for medical waste, in the stalling area. All needles or other sharps must be disposed of in a sharps container.

STALLION OWNERS: We have no control regarding the gender of the horses in the adjoining stalls. **It is the RESPONSIBILITY of the Stallion owners to provide equipment or barriers to protect their horse as well as the neighboring horses. Barriers are available from MSU for a fee.**

PLEASE NOTE: A great deal of effort has been made to eliminate errors in this Show Prize list. If corrections are necessary, they will be posted at the Show Office. Please look for any corrections before registering to avoid any problems or misunderstanding.

AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

All stall reservations should be mailed with your entries before MAY 12, 2009. However, if unwanted advanced reserved stalls are not canceled by MAY 20, they will be charged to your account. Due to the shortage of stalls, the show management reserves the right to reassign tack stalls for use as additional horse stalls if needed.

If you have specific or special stall requirements, contact **SHERYL CARLEN** as early as possible. All requests will be handled on a first come basis.

SHAVINGS /HAY /STRAW will be available on the grounds for purchase from MSU. MSU has the exclusive right to sell bedding & hay at the facility. The sale or delivery of shavings by non-MSU commercial persons is not allowed. **Prior to May 29th, call (517) 432-5566 or the Show Office, (517) 432-5568, for pre-delivery of shavings to your stalls.** Payment will be made directly to MSU. MSU personnel will accept open checks.

STABLING: Stalls are mandatory for all horses. No showing from trailers. **A stall assignment map will be posted at the show office and at the auditorium.** Due to the shortage of stalls, the show management reserves the right to reassign tack stalls for use as additional horse stalls if needed. All stalls in the Pavilion have cement floors with doors. All stalls in the South Barn have dirt floors with doors. Please request the South Barn if you would like stalls with dirt floors. Stalls are approximately 10' x 10'. Tape, stickers, nails, tacks, staples, hooks, screws and other objects shall not be placed in the facilities walls, doors, floors, ceilings, trees, posts or stalls. Exhibitors will be responsible for the cost of repairing damage or alterations to stalls. No changes in stabling will be permitted without Barn Manager's permission. No first bedding will be provided. Shavings and hay will be available on the grounds for purchase from MSU. The MSU Pavilion has the exclusive right to sell bedding and hay at the facility. Proper disposal of empty shaving bags is required. Anyone using a stall not assigned to him by the barn management will be assessed an additional charge of \$60.00. Cross tying of horses in aisles is prohibited.

REFUNDS - Request for refunds must be submitted in writing prior to June 15th. Refunds will be made at the discretion of the show committee. No refunds will be made prior to the end of the show. Entry fees will be refunded

in the event of class cancellation due to severe weather or other emergency. There will be no refunds of office & stall fees.

GENERAL RULES

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book, Arabian Division and National Show Horse Division; will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith; except all Equitation classes in the Arabian and Half Arabian Divisions shall be conducted in accordance with USEF Rules and modified by AHA Equitation Rules found in the current AHA Handbook, which may be obtained in writing: AHA, 10805 E. Bethany Dr, Aurora CO. 80014. Questions not covered by US Equestrian Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and its decisions will be final. All persons who participate in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to all USEF and AHA rules.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF Rule GR1401: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license, which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against persons who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include but not limited to exclusion of the child and parent(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed in accordance with USEF Rules. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

US Equestrian Amateur Certification: Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess current

amateur certification issued by USEF. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the show secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification. Application forms are available at the show office. A \$30 Amateur Card fee will be charged to the exhibitor for any USEF non-member.

AHA SINGLE EVENT FEES: Each participant with an Arab/Half-Arab must submit a current AHA competition card or pay a \$30.00 single event fee per person per horse. This includes any recorded owner, trainer, driver, rider or halter handler, and the person signing the entry blank.

Leased Horses: A leased horse does not constitute ownership in an amateur class. Horses entered in amateur owner or junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family as defined by USEF Rules. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contracts or bills of sale will not be accepted.

Call System: There will be a call system to the barns. The call system is a courtesy only. Classes will be called with reasonable advance notice. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in consecutive classes or in multiple show rings. Exhibitors are responsible for determining when their classes will be judged.

Gate Time: Two (2) minutes will be allowed after the first horse enters the ring. This time limit will be enforced. A three (3) minute hold may be requested for a class at the announcer's platform.

Judging Systems: Performance and Halter classes will be judged and scored using the Single Judge Scoring System. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, the show committee reserves the right to substitute judges and/or show officials per USEF Rules.

Class Specifications: Show management is charged with the responsibility of enforcing all US Equestrian and AHA rules.

Personal Conduct - Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver or any member of the family of the person participating in the show will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a groom, horse, rider or driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. The show management will aid the judges in avoiding contact with the exhibitors or their agents before and during the show.

Liability: All entries are made and accepted with the understanding that the Half Arabian Assoc. of Michigan and the Michigan State University will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or to any property or equipment. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee, but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Half Arabian Assoc. of Michigan and the Michigan State University against any and all damages, loss and liability thus occasioned, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submission of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing of all provisions herein set forth in this document.

Drugs and Medication: Each recognized show must assess the exhibitors a USEF drug fee per horse, in all divisions except Leadline, of \$15.00.

Definitions

MAIDEN, NOVICE, LIMIT RIDER/DRIVER /HORSE classes are open to rider/driver/horses who have **not won one (1), three (3) or six (1) first place ribbon(s)**

respectively at Regular Arabian Division Competitions in that particular performance section in which they are shown.

JUNIOR HORSES - A Junior Horse is defined as **FIVE (5)** years old and under.

A JUNIOR EXHIBITOR is one who has not reached his or her 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competitive year.

I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.
